ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGE POINT GRANTS EXPLAINED 2024

With 1 million electric vehicles (EVs) registered in the UK, they are revolutionising transportation and driving us towards a greener future. To support this transition further, the UK government offers various grants to facilitate the installation of EV charging points. This document provides a concise overview of these grants, highlighting eligibility criteria and key details.



Workplace Charging Scheme for State-Funded Education Institutions

- Eligibility: State-funded schools and education institutions in England, Wales, Scotland, and Northern Ireland.
- Grant Amount: £2,500 per socket, with a maximum of 40 sockets per institution.
- Requirements: Off-street parking facilities, site survey confirmation, no prior grants for the same charge point.
- Funding Duration: Until 31st March 2025.



EV Charge Point Grant for Renters and Flat Owners

- Eligibility: Flat owners and renters in residential properties in the UK.
- Grant Amount: 75% of the installation cost, up to £350 per socket.
- Requirements: OZEV-approved electric vehicles, property ownership or tenancy, off-street parking.
- Funding Duration: Until 31st March 2025.





ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGE POINT GRANTS EXPLAINED 2024



EV Charge Point and Infrastructure Grant for Business Staff and Fleet Car Parks

- Eligibility: Small and medium-sized businesses with up to 249 employees.
- Grant Amount: 75% of the infrastructure cost, up to £15,000, covering charge points and supporting infrastructure.
- Requirements: UK-based property, off-street parking for staff vehicles, OZEV-approved installers and charge points, among others.
- Funding Duration: Until 31st March 2025.



EV Charge Point and Infrastructure Grant for Landlords, Including Car Parks

- Eligibility: Residential and commercial landlords, property management companies, and public sector organizations.
- **Grant Amount:** Up to 75% off the installation cost, with specific limits for residential and commercial properties.
- Requirements: UK-based property, off-street parking, use of OZEV-approved installers and charge points.
- Funding Duration: Until 31st March 2025.
